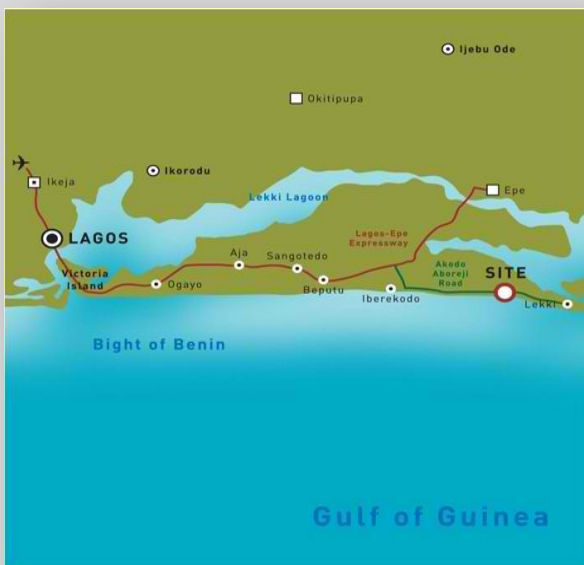

OVERVIEW

A-Cubed Consulting was retained (as Ports of Africa) by Pembani Remgro Infrastructure Managers in November 2012 to assist in specific aspects of a due diligence study on the planned greenfield Port Lekki in Nigeria.

The opportunity of investing in the development of Port Lekki on Nigeria's seaboard required that the client was familiar with all facets of the opportunity in order to correctly assess its value and potential.

SCOPE OF WORK & METHODOLOGY

The scope of work comprised of two elements, namely a review of freight traffic projected for the port and the proposed port facilities to service such traffic.

Following a site visit and project meetings with other consultants and various stakeholders in Lagos, the consulting team were able to contextualise the demand for such a facility in Nigeria against a backdrop of other port initiatives and developments in the area and regionally, along with the impacts of rapid growth in Nigeria's GDP.

The impact on the existing and planned road transport routes to the port also received close consideration.

Supported by further research and a literature review, this enabled an informed and impartial view of the elements to be formed, which guided the study.
