INSPECTION SERVICES

Inspection Services in the port enables us to:

SUPERINTENDENCE SERVICES

Superintendence Services are customised to suit your requirements, and may include:

- **Inspect** stockpile inventory.
- **Coordinate** vessel arrival & departure information.
- **Witness** the hold cleanliness inspection.
- **Perform or monitor** the draft survey: initial, final and any intermediate.
- **Monitor** cargo loading operations.
- **Oversee** the sample collection throughout the loading.
- **Witness** the sample preparation.
- **Supervise** the preparation and sealing of the samples
- **Collate** splits of all samples.
- **Organise** the analysis of the samples, (when required).
- **Perform** periodic measurement of cargo temperature in the hatch



Typical Reporting

DAILY UPDATE REPORT

Routine status report of vessel loading status, sampling done, weather

CRITICAL INCIDENT REPORT

Non-routine occurrences are reported immediately such as loading stoppages

FINAL REPORTS

- Summary of the Superintendence Service for the shipment
- Vessel Draft Survey Report

ANALYSIS REPORT

Certificate of Analysis, if required
