OVERVIEW

The opportunity of investing in the phosphate mining industry in Togo required that the client, Jonah Capital was familiar with all facets of the opportunity in order to correctly assess the facility's worth and potential.

A-Cubed (as Ports of Africa) were appointed to consider the logistics (inbound and outbound) and port engineering elements of the due diligence assignment.

SCOPE OF WORK & METHODOLOGY

The scope in terms of the logistics element covered the productivity and performance of the mine's offshore jetty and loading and discharge appliances.

The methodology used included a visit to the Jetty at the Port of Kpémé in Togo and an analysis of the performance of all vessels that had called at the Jetty in the previous six months, using the Statement of Fact for each performing vessel.

This analysis enabled a profile of the Jetty's performance to be constructed and issues identified that may have a bearing on investment and future marine operations that could affect capital and or operational expenses and exposure to risk.
